

Saskatoon Gun Club Member Screening Protocol

PRIOR To Attendance and Shooting at the Saskatoon Gun Club:

- Club members should review the SGC website daily and they should not come to the facility if they meet even one of the following conditions. The club member will then again be screened at the time of arrival for the following to determine if they display or disclose any signs or symptoms of the following:
 - Have you been exposed to a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
 - Have you had a positive COVID-19 test within the last month and/or are you awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test?
 - Do you or anyone in your household have a new or worsening cough and shortness of breath?
 - Do you or anyone in your household have symptoms of a fever (> 37.8°C)?
 - Do you have or have you had the shakes, chill, severe headache, runny nose, nausea, diarrhea or vomiting in the last 24 hours?
 - In the past 14 days have you traveled outside of Canada to any other locations?
- On the day of attendance at the club, the club member will self-declare and provide the attached documentation of a self-declared COVID-19 screen having been completed on the date of attendance to the club with negative answers to all screening questions. A temperature screen will also be completed.

IN PERSON On-Site SCREENING PROTOCOL

Prior to Using the Saskatoon Gun Club facility, the following protocol will be followed on your date of attendance:

1. Members will check in at the Manager's desk at the Clubhouse upon arrival at the facility. Members will enter the east entrance of the clubhouse and follow the markers on the floor, exiting the south door by the washrooms.
2. Members will complete the COVID 19 Screening Questionnaire on the date of attendance and hand it in at the manager's desk. This will include a temperature screen and you must not be >37.8 C
3. Members need to be aware that expanded cleaning and disinfecting of common and high touch surfaces are in effect in accordance with the most recent Public Health Order. Members are responsible for reviewing on the SGC website prior to each visit and for assisting with our intention to comply.
4. Physical distancing must be observed at all times, with a minimum of two meters of space between individuals.
5. No more than 10 people are allowed to gather at any one time in a particular area.
6. The manager's desk remains open and members will have access to washroom facilities by entering the east door of the building and exiting through the south door of the building. Please follow the signage and instructions that are in place at the club.
7. Indoor clubhouse socializing activities will be completely closed until Phase 4 of Re-Open Saskatchewan. Therefore, all food & beverage services are currently suspended until further notice.
8. Equipment rentals are available but increased cleaning and disinfecting procedures will be in place.
9. Individual instruction is permissible but with no contact and ongoing physical distancing measures must be respected.

Part C: Decision Protocol:

- If the SGC member answers **NO** to all of the screening questions & is a **PASS** to the temperature screen: The member is cleared to use the shooting facilities, observing social distancing measures in place.
- If the SGC member answers **NO** to all of the screening questions but is a **FAIL** for the temperature screen: The member is not allowed to use the shooting facilities and should excuse themselves from the property.
- If the SGC member has answered **YES TO ANY** of the above questions, they will not be able to access club facilities and should follow the protocol below:
 - If they answer **Yes to Question 1** or if they **report symptoms** related to COVID-19 and answer **YES to Question 2 & 3** such as a new/worse cough, fever and or shortness of breath they should self-isolate at home immediately and contact their local public health authority by calling the Healthline at 811 for further guidance. They should not return to the SGC until they have been cleared by their local public health authority.
 - If they answer **Yes to Question 4** they should not return to the SGC until they have been symptom free for a minimum of 24 hours.
 - If they answer **Yes** to Question 5 regarding travel outside Canada they can be reminded to follow the Public Health Order and enter the **14-day quarantine** timeframe and be symptom free for 14 days before returning to the SGC.
